

NO SEAM MAGIC PILLOWCASE OUR WAY

Fabric Requirements:

Regular Pillowcase		King Size	Travel
3/4 yard (27"X WOF)	Body	1 yard	18" X 30"
1/3 yard (12"XWOF)	Cuff	1/3 yard	9" X 30"
1/8 yard (3"XWOF)	Trim	1/8 yard	2"1/2 X 30"

(For the **Trim** we use 2"1/2 - 3" so that it will not flap after it is laundered.)

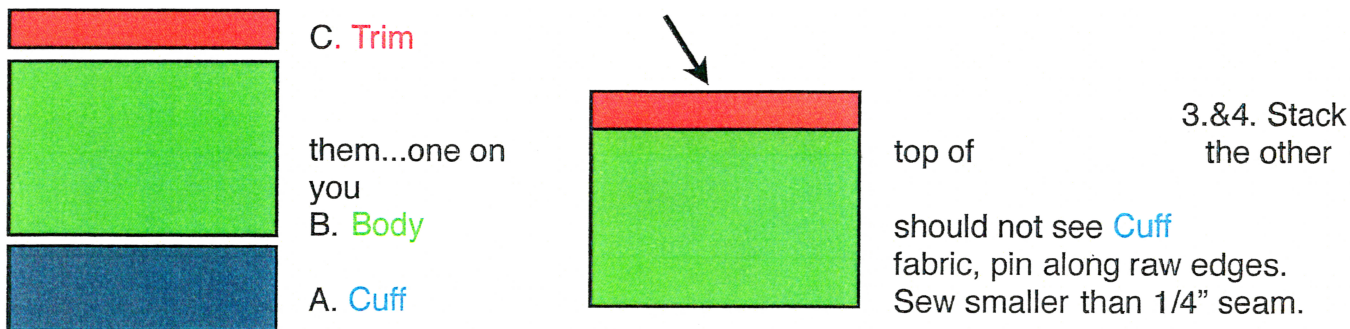
1. Cut off Selvage

2. Iron all fabric smooth, getting rid of center fold. *Fold and press the **Trim** fabric in half, **wrong sides** together.* (**Trim** fabric can be an option.)

3. Lay fabrics down in the following order **Right Sides Up**, raw edges close to you.

A. **Cuff** Fabric down first then B. **Body** Fabric on top of **Cuff** fabric and then C. **Trim** Fabric on top of **Body** Fabric.

4. Pin the three layers and sew a smaller than 1/4" seam along raw edges.



5. Start rolling here.

5. Roll up **Body Fabric** till you *almost* get to **Trim Fabric**, this will reveal the **Cuff Fabric**. Take the **Cuff Fabric** and **pull it over** rolled **Body Fabric** and **Trim Fabric**...pin to raw edges that were just sewn.

6. Sew a 1/2" seam beside the 1/4" seam that was just sewn. This forms a fabric tube.

7. Reach into one end of the fabric tube and pull out the pillowcase body. Press **Cuff**.

8. *Then sew a French Seam.* Pin side and bottom-**right sides out**. Sew(appx.1/4") seam, side and bottom of the pillowcase ...then turn the pillowcase inside out and sew a wider seam(1/2") along the side and bottom seams that was just sewn on the right side.(Don't want to see the first seam when you turn back to right side. This will give you pillowcase a more finished look. Press seams. *A Pillowcase makes a good storage bag for your quilts.*
