Back ground white

A-1- 4 1/2" sq

B-1-3 1/2"x 9 1/2"

C-1-3 1/2"x 6 1/2"

D-1-3 1/2" sq

E-2-2 1/2"x 3 1/2"

Hat

F-1-6 1/2" sq

G-1-3 1/2" sq

H-1-2 1/2"x 3 1/2"

I-1-2 1/2"x 3 1/2"

J-1-1 1/2"x 12 1/2"

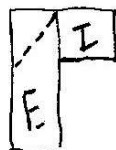
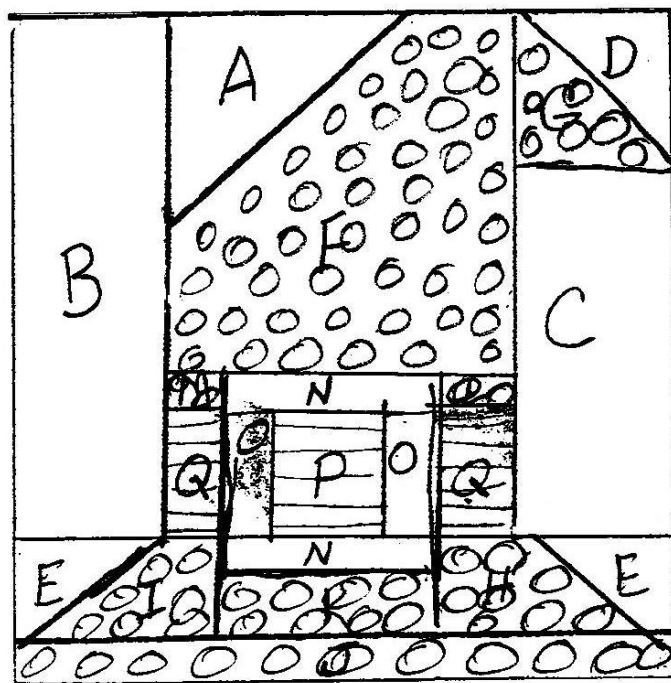
N-2-1 1/2"x 4 1/2"

Take piece A and draw a line diagonally. Place on piece F on upper left hand corner and stitch on line. Trim.

Take pieces M-N-L sew together. Sew to piece F.

Take pieces Q-O-P-O-Q sew together. Sew to bottom of M-N-L.

Draw diagonal line on piece D lay on piece G and sew on line, trim.

Add to top of piece C. Add to right side of assembled unit.

Add piece B to left side of assembled unit.

Take piece E and mark down 2 1/2" on the 3 1/2" side(see diagram) Add to Fabric I. Stitch on line, trim. Take the other piece E and mark on opposite side stitch. Trim.

Take pieces N-K stitch together.

Add the above pieces to each side, with back ground to the outside.

Add this unit to the bottom of hat unit.

Add piece J to bottom of hat.
