

SALVATION ARMY QUILT BLOCKS

We were contacted by a representative from the Salvation Army Homeless Shelter asking if our guild could possibly donate up to 4 queen-size quilts next year for individuals who are moving into a home after being homeless. We discussed this proposal at the We Care Bee and decided that since we have had 2 generous donations of fabric this year, we could meet this request. We are going to start by asking anyone who is willing to help us make scrappy blocks. These blocks are 10 ½" unfinished and it will take 90 blocks to make each top. Here are the two block instructions and pictures.

SALLY BLOCKS



You need:

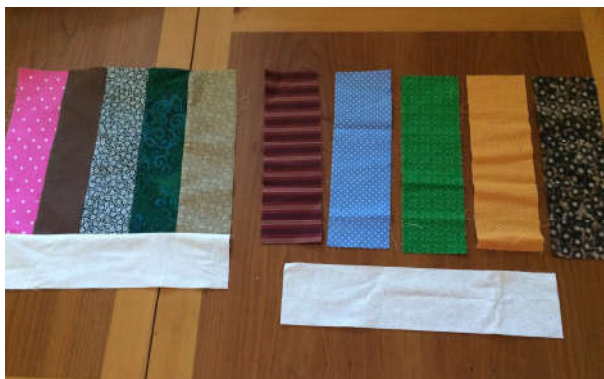
*Fabric A – 8 – 2 ½" **white** squares*

*Fabric B – 9 – 2 ½" **medium or dark matching squares***

*Fabric C – 4 – 2 ½" x 4 ½" **rectangles coordinating matching rectangles***

Assemble like picture. Makes one 10 ½" x 10 ½" block.

STEPPER BLOCKS



You need:

*5 – 2 ½" x 8 ½" **scrappy strips***

*1 – 2 ½" x 10 ½" **cream strip***

Assemble like picture. Makes one 10 ½" x 10 ½" block.
